Spring Gardening Tips

Spring Gardening Tips Grow Best Liquid Plant Food

- **Transplanting flowers, plants and vegetables:** Reduce transplant shock and speed root development. Get your transplanted flowers, plants and vegetables off to a fast start by watering them in with one tablespoon (tbsp.) per gallon of Grow Best. Once they are established, use 2 tbsp/gal. for in-ground plants twice per mo.
- **Transplanting trees and shrubs in the ground:** Water in with two tbsp./gal for great results. Continue every 3-4 weeks.
- **Seedlings:** After planting seeds, soak the soil with 1 tbsp/gal of GB. Once the seeds have sprouted and reached 2" high, fertilize seedlings lightly with same solution every two weeks.
- **Cuttings:** Immerse cuttings snipped on the diagonal in 1 tbsp/gal of GB for five minutes, then plant in potting soil. Fertilize with same solution every 2-3 weeks to prevent wilting.
- **Herbs:** Fertilize once/week with a light spray of 1 tbsp/gal.

Easy Directions

- **For Outdoor Plants, Flowers, Vegetables:** Apply two tablespoons (tbsp.)/gal of water every 2 weeks. Can apply with a hose-end sprayer.
- **A Grow Best pint makes 16 gallons of fertilizer solution.**
- **For Indoor Plants, Hanging Baskets, and Container Plants:** Apply one tbsp/gal every 2 weeks. Except for African Violets (see below), spray leaves of indoor plants regularly for shiny and healthy leaves.
- **For Orchids, African Violets, Bromeliads:** Apply 1 teaspoon/gal every week or two. Use plain water every 4-5 weeks. Spray leaves of Orchids and Bromeliads, but keep African violet leaves dry.
- **GB is non-burning. Can safely use on:** Roses, Annuals, Bulbs, Perennials, Azaleas, Ferns, Pansies, Mums, Vegetables, Tomatoes, Herbs, Indoor Plants, Hanging Baskets, Container Plants, African Violets, Bromeliads, Orchids, Fruit Bearing Trees and Plants.
